

RESOLUTION NO. 2026- 10

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE DISTRICT TOWNSHIP
RESOLUTION CONCERNING FEES

WHEREAS the Second-Class Township Code and/or municipal codes passed by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania grant to Municipalities power to adopt a fee schedule; and,

WHEREAS District Township (the Township) Adopted Resolution 2026-2 on January 5, 2026, setting fees for various applications, appeals, permits, and the like; and

WHEREAS on May 21, 2026, the Township Adopted Ordinance 2026-02 named and identified as the District Township Street Occupancy Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS the Township wishes to adopt the appropriate fees relating to this newly adopted ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals, which are incorporated herein by reference and made part hereof, the Board of Supervisors of District Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly convened hereby resolves and adopts as follows:

1. The District Township Resolution 2026-2 is hereby amended by adding the following fees regarding the District Township Street Occupancy Ordinance as follows:

District Township Street Opening Ordinance – Fee Schedule


Application Review Fee	\$200.00
Permit Issuance Fee	\$50.00
Inspection Fees	
Minimum Inspection Fee (openings/borings)*	\$250.00
Opening in cartway (each 100' increment)	\$100.00
Opening in shoulder (each 100' increment)	\$50.00
Boring under cartway/shoulder (each 100' increment)	\$25.00
Placement of new poles (each)	\$25.00

* Minimum inspection fee shall be charged if calculated fee based upon length of opening/boring is less than \$250.00. Minimum inspection fee shall not apply to placement of new poles.

2. All other portions of Resolution Number 2026-2 are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.


